EXCLUSION NOTICE FOR VACCINE-PREVENTABLE DISEASE

When an outbreak of a vaccine-preventable disease occurs in our school, the Southwest Utah Public Health Department has the authority (R396-100-8) to exclude from school any student that is not immunized against the disease.

- 1. To reduce your child's risk of exposure to the disease by those who are infectious.
