Dear Parent/Guardian;

Your child is exhibiting one or more of the following signs/symptoms. He/she may have a communicable disease or a condition that requires treatment.

*(Check all that apply)*

- Abdominal pain
- Acute cold symptoms
- Antibiotic use: Any child on an antibiotic will not be accepted into the daycare until he/she has been on antibiotics for three (3) days
- Diarrhea (more than one abnormally loose stool)
- Difficulty breathing
- Earache
- Eyes that are red, inflamed or have pus discharge (non-allergic)
- Gray or white stools
- Headaches or stiff neck
- Irritability/persistent crying
- Labored or rapid breathing (significant in infants less than six months old)
- Lethargy (sluggishness, profound drowsiness)
- Nausea/vomiting
- Persistent cough
- Rash that is accompanied by a behavior change
- Rash that is accompanied with a fever
- Rash that is oozing
- Running nose (non allergic)
- Sore throat/difficulty swallowing
- Sores with ongoing fluid drainage, or blisters with yellow odorous pus
- Suspected infestations (Scabies, Head lice, Pinworms)
- Temperature greater than 100.4 F
- Toothache or teething at its worst
- Suspected Impetigo
- Suspected Ringworm
- Swollen glands under/around jaws, ears, or neck
- Other signs/symptoms that suggests acute illness \_\_\_\_\_

**Your child needs to stay home until one of the following is met:**

- **Signs and symptoms are gone**
- **24 hours of treatment are completed**
- **You bring a doctor's or dentist's note that states he/she may return to school**
