For approvals in grades K - 5, the application will be reviewed annually and a new application is required. For grades 6 - 12, the approval is not subject to re-application but still subject to the conditions above. The approval is only for the applicant. Siblings must apply and be approved separately and approval is not guaranteed.

Utah High School Activities Association (UHSAA) guidelines and policies apply relative to transfer students in grades 9 - 12 who participate in athletics and activities. It is the duty of the student and parent to understand the policies and ensure the student is eligible to participate in UHSAA sanctioned activities. An approved transfer does NOT indicate the student is UHSAA eligible. Application for eligibility is a separate process. The question of UHSAA eligibility must be answered before the student tries out or participates with any UHSAA sanctioned team, activity or event.

Transportation to and from the requested school is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. No buses are provided.

Applications may be reviewed at any time and are subject to revocation.
