3.2. Ways To Conserve Energy

- 3.2.1. When leaving the room, turn off lights, close windows, doors, etc.
- 3.2.2. Eliminate unnecessary lighting by using only the lighting that is needed; sections of halls, rooms, etc.
- 3.2.3. Watch for and control areas that can conserve energy; open doors, windows, etc.
- 3.2.4. Keep thermostats regulated at proper room temperatures. (Generally these are set and controlled by custodians.)

3.2.5. Become efficient in eliminating waste to save money and reduce the demand on scarce resources.
