Siblings must apply and be approved separately and approval is not guaranteed.
		Utah High School Activities Association (UHSAA) guidelines and policies apply relative to transfer students in grades 9 - 12 who participate in athletics and activities. It is the duty of the student and parent to understand the policies and ensure the student is eligible to participate in UHSAA sanctioned activities. An approved transfer does NOT indicate the student is UHSAA eligible. Application for eligibility is a separate process.
		Students must be enrolled in and attend class(es) in person for grades 6-12.
		Transportation to and from the requested school is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. No buses are provided.
