Your child is exhibiting one or more of the following signs/symptoms. He/she may have a communicable disease or a condition that requires treatment.	
	Abdominal pain Acute cold symptoms Antibiotic use: Any child on an antibiotic will not be accepted into the daycare until he/she has been on antibiotics for three (3) days Diarrhea (more than one abnormally loose stool) Difficulty breathing Earache Eyes that are red, inflamed or have pus discharge (non-allergic) Gray or white stools Headaches or stiff neck Irritability/persistent crying Labored or rapid breathing (significant in infants less than six months old) Lethargy (sluggishness, profound drowsiness) Nausea/vomiting Persistent cough Rash that is accompanied by a behavior change Rash that is accompanied with a fever Rash that is ozing Running nose (non allergic) Sore throat/difficulty swallowing Sores with ongoing fluid drainage, or blisters with yellow odorous pus Suspected infestations (Scabies, Head lice, Pinworms) Temperature greater than 100.4 F Toothache or teething at its worst Suspected Impetigo Suspected Ringworm Swollen glands under/around jaws, ears, or neck Other signs/symptoms that suggests acute illness

## Your child needs to stay home until one of the following is met:

- Signs and symptoms are gone
- 24 hours of treatment are completed
- You bring a doctor's or dentist's note that states he/she may return to school
